Covington, Kentucky, 30 September 2005 -- *The Encyclopedia of Northern Kentucky* will feature 1,200 illustrated pages in a single authoritative volume, detailing the history, geography, politics, culture, science, and economy of the 11 counties of Northern Kentucky. A non-profit project of the Thomas D. Clark Foundation, Forward Quest, and the University Press of Kentucky, the encyclopedia is pleased to announce the achievement of several important targets:

- **Fundraising** amounting to **three-fourths** (i.e. \$454,000) of the total four-year budget of \$704,500.
- The **halfway point** of the project, with two years completed and two years remaining.
- **Over 800** of the 2,000 encyclopedia entries have been submitted and are undergoing editing by a staff of four editors. Three of the editors hold the Ph.D. degree, and the fourth editor has two master's degrees.
- Selective **indexing** of the *Kentucky Post* is being completed for the period 1932-1982; over 5,000 newspaper citations have been added to the website at www.nkyencyclopedia.org. Look under "Reference Tools," and then "Newspaper Index, 1932-1982." 10,000+ citations will be added over the next few months.
- Completion of the manuscript is **on schedule** for January 2007.
